

The stellar beauty of five alpine lakes lapped in the dreamscape of Kashmir - can you think of a more beautiful combination? Kashmir Great Lakes is a name that sets every trekker's heart racing - and for good reason! The Great Lakes of Kashmir Trek is easily the most beautiful, picture-perfect, postcard-worthy trek we run. The trail of this Himalayan Trekking leads you through Six alpine lakes, each as beautiful as the other. The lakes follow one after the other every day, making each day equally exciting. Remember the rush and excitement of a pass day/summit day? Well, multiply all of that by 5, and you have the Kashmir Great Lakes Trekking - each day a beautiful, new lake to look forward to. What's more interesting is that you get to see these lakes just as they are being fed by the snow-clad mountains. If you are lucky enough, you may even chance upon an occasional iceberg floating across the pristine blues and greens of the lake. The beautiful, albeit distorted reflections of the surrounding mountains on the surface of the lake, is also something to look forward to. Given the arduous, undulating trail, Kashmir Great Lakes Trekking demands commendable fitness.

#### DAY - 1 Arrive in Srinagar and tranfer to base camp - Shitkadi

Altitude: 9,187 ft.

Distance: 80 km



# DAY - 2 Trek from Sonamarg to Nichnai via Shekdur

Altitude: 11,500 ft

Distance: 11 km



# DAY - 3 Trek from Nichnai to Vishnusar Lake

Altitude: 12,000 ft

Distance: 13 km



# DAY - 4 Trek from Vishnusar to Gadsar Via

Kishansar lake & Gadsar Pass

Altitude: 12,500 ft via 13,800 ft

Distance: 16 km

Altitude: 7,450 ft Distance: 13 km

- All the persons participating in the Camp will have to follow the instructions and listen to the guidelines given by the Camp In-charge/Camp

Manager/Instructors/Team Leader.

- Respecting each fellow person in the camp and the values of the organization.
- Participants will have to be punctual to the schedule.
- Tobacco/Alcohol is strictly prohibited during the camp duration.
- Please refrain from bringing expensive items like watches, jewellery which might be at a risk of theft. We are not responsible for the losses incurred if such an instance is to occur.
- Any kind of mischief/misbehaviour with the camp incharge persons or the management staff or any other fellow participant will not be tolerated and strict action would be taken against the guilty person. In extreme cases, it may also lead to the cancellation of participation.
- Use of any bad/vulgar/indecent language during the camp is strictly condemned.
- In case of any disputes, decision of camp manager would be considered to be final.
- No harm should be done to the wildlife and the jungle terrain/camp site/private property.
- Plastic/wrappers/other waste should be disposed at proper place only.
